#### **RULES FOR SCHOOL COMPETITIONS**

- 1. A student can take part in three individual items and two group items and any numbers of open competitions.
- 2. A student can participate in any open competition just by giving his/ her name to the House Masters or House teacher one week before the competition.
- 3. No name will be written on the day of competition/ spot entries will be not entertained.
- 4. There will be negative marking if time is exceeded in any competition.
- 5. Participant's number as mentioned against each competition will be strictly followed.
- 6. Specific Topics for the competitions will be given 7-10 days in advance as per the activity.
- 7. Drawing/ Clay modeling: Participants may use crayons, pencil colors or poster colors for depicting the theme, as directed by drawing teacher according to class.
- 8. Science model: Students can participate in group (maximum-4) or individual.
- 9. Quiz: Screening to be done by the house members in advance,.
- 10. Entries for all activities should be submitted to the CCA in charges duly signed by the House Masters, a day in advance.
